#### The framework

Lombardy region defined, in the S3 Regional Strategy the sustainability of the tourism in mountain areas as a specific objective for next 5 years and the sustainable and accessible sport. The same objective is indicated in the Regional Strategy for the Sustainable Development as declared during the Forum for the Sustainable Development in November 2021 and 2023





To reach this goals, a lot of strategic project have been implemented in last 4 years or are already in phase of implementation in order to **capitalize** results of old experimentation and in order to test **new solution and measures** able to support the raching defined in the two strategies







## The Alpine Space NOVALTITUDE project

Regione Lombardia recently approved a new law on Renewable Energy Communities. The NOVALTITUDE project aims at providing:

- One of the first sites in Lombardy where the new law applied in real-life conditions
- First energy community in mountains connected to a ski resort in Italy
- Big interest of local decision-makers to experiment and establish new models of self energy production/consumption
- Potential integration with new mobility models based on shared electrical vehicles

Within the project the objective is to promote the establishment of a local energy community connected to ski resort and emobility for sustainable mountain tourism
